DOG LICENSES:

12/1/17

All dogs over 5 months of age need to be licensed and tagged every year between January 1st and April 1st from your Town Treasurer. Proof of current rabies vaccination is required along with Driver's License number and current phone number. If the dog is kept in La Crosse County, (*outside the city limits*) the current year tag fee for a spayed or neutered dog is **\$12.00** and for a dog that has not been spayed or neutered it is **\$23.00**. **Make check payable to**

\$25 LATE FEE: If you fail to purchase the tag for your licensable dog by April 1st, you **MUST** pay a \$25 penalty, **PER DOG**, in addition to the cost of the tag. After April 1st tag purchases requiring payment of this late penalty must be acquired at the County Clerk's office at 212 6th Street North, Rm 1500 La Crosse WI

This also applies if you get a new dog and fail to license it within 30 days, if your puppy turns 5 months old and you fail to license it or if you move into the County with a dog and fail to license it within 30 days.

The tag number, rabies data, and required information on each owner and dog are kept on file for reference. If you find a lost dog with a La Crosse County tag, you may call The County Clerk's office for the owner information on file.

La Crosse County ordinance requires all dogs to be kept on a leash and all waste is to be picked up and disposed of properly.
