Town of Greenfield Recycling Center

The Town of Greenfield has an ordinance to promote recycling, compost of materials and resources recovery as set forth in the State Statutes.

To carry out a proper, safe and efficient program the Town is providing you with the following information.

- 1. The Town Recycling Center is located at W2870 Kreibich Coulee Rd.
 - (a) Summer Hours April 1st to October 31st Tuesday 4pm to pm and Saturday 8am to 2 pm.
 - (b) Winter Hours November 1st to March 31st Tuesday 1pm to 4pm and Saturday 8am to 2 pm.
- 2. Following is a list of materials to be collected and instruction of preparation of materials for recycling.
 - (a) Aluminum containers, bi metal containers, glass bottles and jars shall be rinsed clean and brought to the Recycling Center where a bin is provided for collection. Do not mix pyrex cookware, mirrors or window glass with the aforementioned items. The pyrex cookware, mirrors and window glass should be placed in the open top bin.
 - (b) Brush may be brought to the Recycling Center where an area is provided for collections. It should be less than 6 foot in length. Any wood over 4 inches in diameter should be no longer than 2 feet. Any questions contact the Recycling Director.
 - (c) Newspapers, magazines, plastics, small amounts of clothing, corrugated paper may be brought to the Recycling Center where a compactor bin is available for collection. These will be transported to Xcel Energy Plant for fuel to generate electricity. ONLY MATERIALS THAT BURN GO IN THIS BIN
 - (d) Florescent lamps and light bulbs must be separated from other items. Fee for fluorescent lams 4 feet or more is \$ 1.00. A collection box is located at the Recycling Center.
 - (e) Waste tires may be brought to the Recycling Center. All tires must be removed from the rims. The fees on tires are as follows.
 - (1) Car Tires \$ 2.00 each
 - (2) Truck Tires \$ 5.00 each
 - (3) Large Truck Tires \$ 8.00 each
 - (4) Tractor Tires \$ 15.00 each
 - (5) Bicycle Tires \$ 1.00 each
 - (6) Bicycle Tires on Rims \$ 2.00 each
 - (f) Waste oil from residential unites maybe taken to the Recycling Center where containers are available. Oils cannot be mixed with anti-freeze or gasoline
 - (g) Lead acid batteries will also be collected at the Recycling Center.
 - (h) Yard waste and compost materials maybe brought to the Recycling Center where a bin is available for collection.
 - (i) Major appliances maybe brought to the Recycling Center.
 Major Appliances will not be collected in December, January, and February.
 - (1) Appliance Fee \$15.00 per each appliance.
 - (j) Other items for which a fee is charged are as follows.
 - (1) Lawn mowers \$ 5.00
 - (2) Riding lawn mowers \$ 10.00
 - (3) Construction site waste \$ 20.00 pick up load
 - (4) Construction site waste \$ 40.00 large truck load

- (k) Materials unacceptable by Xcel Energies facility maybe brought to the Recycling Center for transport to the County Landfill. Examples are shingles, furniture, and window dishes, mirrors, carpeting and miscellaneous debris glass.
- 3. Owners are designated agents of multiple family dwellings are required to notify tenants of the Town recycling program.
- 4. Owners are designated agents of non-residential facilities must also participate in an effective recycling program.
- 5. The Town Ordinance provides for penalties for failure to follow recycling regulations. Penalties range from \$ 10.00 to \$ 2,000.00.
- 6. Attendants at the Recycling Center may have the right to inspect the refuse materials.
- Cash payments should be for the exact amounts. Checks are to be made payable to the Town of Greenfield. If the actual amount is not presented the item will be refused.
- 8. Do not leave any waste outside of the gate or throw any waste over the fence. Fines will be assessed for violators.
- 9. Ashes must be cold and maybe put in open top bin.
- 10. Gas tanks or gas cans will be refused.
- 11. Dried out paint pails maybe put in the open top bin only.
- 12. Scrap metal and iron must be separated from items that go the County Landfill.
- 13. It would be preferable that all used clothing be talked to places such as the Salvation Army, Goodwill, and Thrift Shop.
- 14. It maybe to your advantage to take appliances to some other place such as Liberty Appliances of La Crosse. Phone 608-796-0650.

(they may take you appliance free of charge)

- 15. Only the attendant may operate the compactor.
- 16. Please cooperate with our recycling effort. Take time to read your recycling information. Any questions or concerns should be directed to Daryl Servais Recycling Director or the Town Board.
