Monthly Meeting Minutes  
January 12, 2011

The Town Board of the Town of Greenfield met on Wednesday January 12, 2011 at 7:00 PM. at the Town Hall. Present were Chairman Steven Mader, Supervisor Thomas Jacobs, Clerk Kenneth Hess and Treasurer Mary Leuck. Rhonda Helgeson was excused because of a business conflict.

Chairman Mader called the meeting to order. The Pledge of Allegiance to the flag was first on the agenda. The clerk read the minutes of the December meeting. Thomas Jacobs made a motion to approve the minutes. Steve Mader seconded the motion. The motion passed. The minutes did include the filing of nomination papers for the various Town offices. Papers filed were Chairman Steve Mader, Supervisor #1 Rhonda Helgeson, Supervisor #2 Thomas Jacobs, Town Clerk Lois Meinking and Town Treasurer Mary Leuck. No opposition nominees were made. Incumbent Town Clerk Kenneth Hess is not a candidate.

Dallas Kammel a La Crosse High School student attended the meeting as part of a school assignment. A Certificate of Attendance was signed by the Clerk.

The sand/salt shed was discussed briefly. We will construct a new one in the summer of 2011.

Marie Strangstalien has requested an extension of a temporary permit to reside in a mobile home. She also asked that she be not required to ask for the extension every 6 months. The County requires that. Thomas Jacobs made a motion to approve the 6 month extension. Steve Mader seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Custom Excavating application for a Conditional Use Permit has been approved by the County with several conditions. Town action will be at the February 9<sup>th</sup> meeting

Donald Bina who represents Greenfield on the County Board attended this meeting.

The Town agreed to join in the Household Hazardous Waste Program. This program is run by the County.

The Town signed an agreement with the County to participate in a rebate program in connection with solid waste. A discussion was held concerning recycling. TV's can be taken to the Hazardous Waste. A fee of \$15.00 is charged,

Hilltoppers will accept various electronics.

Oil Filters may be collected in a separate container. Rock Oil Company collects the oil and oil filters.

Barry Nelson suggested that Dynamic Recycling be checked for recycling information.

Terry Mlsna who set up our insurance program with Coverra was present. At that time he was with Mark Anderson Company. Mr. Mlsna has changed agencies but still represents Coverra. Only Mark Anderson or Mr. Mlsna can represent Coverra in our area. The Board will study the matter and put it on the February agenda.

Town elections will be April 5, 2011. No Primary is necessary for Town Election but there will be a Primary on February 15 for Justice of the Supreme Court.

County Supervisor Donald Bina informed the Board of a problem with a road sign at the intersection of Wuensch Road and a road leading to Steve Miller farm and Stark Road. The Town Board will study the problem and will hope to have a plan by February meeting,

In a Citizen's Comments a problem with the road sign on Schams Avenue and Ridgeview Drive was pointed out.

The Chairman expressed his appreciation for the efforts made by the road workers in snowplowing.

Monthly bills were paid.
