Monthly Meeting Minutes
February 9th, 2011

The Town Board of the Town of Greenfield met at 7:00 PM. on Wednesday February 9th at the Town Hall. Present were Chairman Steven Mader, Supervisors Rhonda Helgeson and Thomas Jacobs, Clerk Kenneth Hess and Treasurer Mary Leuck. .

Chairman Mader called the meeting to order. The Pledge of Allegiance to the flag was made. The clerk read the minutes of the January meeting. Thomas Jacobs made a motion to approve the minutes. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. The motion passed. The Treasurer gave the monthly financial report. Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to approve the report. Thomas Jacobs seconded the motion. The motion passed.

There were some snow plowing problems at a turnaround in Lost Ridge. Apparently a school bus driver felt that more space should have been available to turn around. The snow plow operators stated they made an initial attempt to have all roads passable, and then they come back and widen the roads.

A Conditional Use Permit for Kammel Custom Excavating was next on the agenda. The County has approved this Permit with several conditions. Thomas Jacobs made a motion to approve the permit with the County Conditions. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Recycling fees were discussed. Fees will be reviewed at the March meeting. The fee schedule will be part of the next newsletter.

Zoning matters were discussed by some residents who reside on County N. There was land that is shown in our Comprehensive Plan as residential but should be Agriculture. The Town Board stated that it was the intent of the Board that this land be Agricultural. Thomas Jacobs made a motion to amend the Plan and ask for a correction. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. The motion passed.

The Town Board will conduct a road inspection beginning at 2:00 PM on April 1, 2011

The Annual Meeting is scheduled for Tuesday April 12 at 7:00 PM at the Town Hall.

Insurance agent Mark Anderson reviewed our insurance coverage. The policy is due April 16, 2011.

Nancy Kroner stated that Steve Mashak should be commended for keeping the sidewalk free of snow from his residence east to the church

Ron Clark thanked the road workers for doing a good job.

Monthly accounts were paid.
