

Town of Greenfield

Monthly Meeting Minutes
March 9th, 2011

The Town Board of the Town of Greenfield was called to order by Chairman Steven Mader at 7:00 PM at the Town Hall on March 9th at the Town Hall. The Pledge of Allegiance to the flag was made. All members of the Board were present: Chairman Steven Mader, Supervisors Rhonda Helgeson and Thomas Jacobs, Clerk Kenneth Hess and Treasurer Mary Leuck. The Clerk read the minutes of the February 9th meeting. Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to approve the minutes. Thomas Jacobs seconded the motion. The motion passed. The Treasurer gave the monthly financial report. Thomas Jacobs made a motion to approve the report. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. The motion passed.

The Town Board has received a bill from the Shelby Fire Department for a fire call on County M caused by the breakage of a power line pole which caused the wire to come down very low on the road and close to a mobile home. Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to bill Vernon Electric for the fire call. Thomas Jacobs seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Francis and Irene Schmidt presented a Certified Survey Map for a parcel they own in Greenfield. Thomas Jacobs made a motion to approve the Survey Map. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion map.

A representative from Mathy Construction informed the Board the Mathy Construction plans to purchase the Bendel Starch quarry. The quarry is along the Ober Road. Mathy Construction will seek a Conditional Use Permit from the County. The Town has no objection to the transfer of the property but is concerned about erosion control. The Town will wait until after the County hearing which is to be held in April before the Town Board makes a final decision.

Al Radke informed the Board that he has a 2 acre parcel of land at the end of Clements Road that he intends to sell for residential purposes. He was reminded that he may have to establish a town road to provide access to the homes. The town road would be his expense. He was told to check with County Zoning concerning his plans.

Fire number signs for the Wuensch Road were next on the agenda. The Wuensch road goes South and West. It was proposed that the fire number signs be placed at the Wuensch road intersection.

Emergency Ambulance service was discussed. Thomas Jacobs made a motion to check it further. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Recycling matters were discussed. Electronic equipment may be recycled. TV's will be accepted at the Recycling Center. There will be a fee of \$15.00 per TV. A motion was made by Rhonda Helgeson to publish a fee schedule in the newsletter. Thomas Jacobs seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Blood Center of Wisconsin will hold a blood drive on Monday May 2, 2011 from 3:00 to 7:00 PM.

A retirement open house is planned for April 17, 2011 from 2:00 to 4:00 PM for retiring clerk Kenneth Hess.

Monthly bills were paid.
