Monthly Meeting Minutes
April 13, 2011

The Town Board of the Town of Greenfield met at 7:00 P.M. on Wednesday, April 13 at the Town Hall. Present were Chairman Steven Mader, Supervisors Rhonda Helgeson and Thomas Jacobs, Clerk Lois Meinking and Treasurer Mary Leuck. Chairman Mader called the meeting to order. The Pledge of Allegiance to the flag was made. The clerk read the minutes of the March meeting. Thomas Jacobs made the motion to approve the minutes. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. The motion passed. The treasurer gave the monthly financial report. Thomas Jacobs made the motion to approve the report. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. The motion passed.

The election report was given. 569 voters participated on April 5th. The next election is May 3.

An emergency ambulance service contract was discussed. The board will review the contract for service with Tri-state. Thomas Jacobs made the motion to table it for 30 days. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Steve Mader gave a report of the district town association meeting and the budget impact on town revenue. Program reduction is estimated at \$14,000.

A conditional use permit was reviewed with Keith from Mathy regarding the Bendel-Starch Quarry (Ober Rd.). Storm water spring snow melt will be handled with a plan to hold back water.

The road inspection was conducted April 1. Bahr Rd., Schams Rd., and Lemke Rd. will be given priority. Road workers were directed to start patching potholes. Motion by Thomas Jacobs to remove road bans April 18 with the exception of Johnson Rd. was made. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. Motion passed.

TVs may be recycled for \$15 if less than 19 inches and \$25 if over 19 inches at the recycling center.

Al Radke presented a survey map and requested changing a lot line (4) in Greenfield Estates. He was directed to get more information.

Charging for fire calls was discussed. Prior to adopting an ordinance it must be published in the paper.

The Muenzenberger Rd. issue was discussed.

Reminders about the blood drive May 2 and open house for retiring clerk, Ken Hess April 17 were made.

There will be a meeting at 6:45 P.M. on May 11 to postpone open book.

Monthly accounts were paid.

Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Thomas Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed.
