Monthly Meeting Minutes
June 8, 2011

The Town Board of the Town of Greenfield met at 7:00 P.M. on Wednesday, June 8, at the Town Hall. Present were Chairman Steven Mader, Supervisors Rhonda Helgeson and Thomas Jacobs, Clerk Lois Meinking, and Treasurer Mary Leuck. Chairman Mader called the meeting to order. The Pledge of Allegiance to the flag was made. The clerk read the minutes of the May meeting. Thomas Jacobs made the motion to approve the minutes. Steve Mader seconded the motion. The motion passed. The treasurer gave the monthly financial report. Thomas Jacobs made the motion to approve the report. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Steve Mader gave the insurance report on the hail damage to the complex roof and park shelter house. Rhonda Helgeson made the motion to put bids out for the same quality roof and shelter repairs to be submitted within 30 days of publication. Thomas Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Charlie Handy was not present to discuss the redistricting plan. However, citizens provided concern. Frustration was expressed that the county is not contacting landowners. It is understood that Ag A and Transitional Ag will be eliminated. Land will be zoned rural residential. If rural residential no more than 3 animal units will be allowed and after 9 acres the land is treated the same as 40 acres. If you own less than 1 ½ acres it will become residential. Originally (1 ½ years ago) the county discussed that people would be able to voluntarily switch over.

The recycling report was given as disposal contracts were discussed from Hilltopper and Harter's. Thomas Jacobs made a motion to hold on the decision 30 days and Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. The motion carried.

The road report was given. There is concern for the culvert by Wuensch Road. Darrell was directed to measure it and get prices for that and others. The potholes will be fixed.

There was no park report.

Steve Mader updated us on possible locations of the ATC power line. Meetings have been scheduled.

Monthly accounts were paid. Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to short term borrow \$30,000 until the end of August. Thomas Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Rhonda Helgeson made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Thomas Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion carried.

A special meeting will be held June 22 at 7:00 P.M. to approve beverage licenses.
