Minutes Town Board Meeting September 14, 2011

The Town of Greenfield Board met at 7:00 P.M. on Wednesday, September 14, 2011 at the Town Hall. Present were Chairman Steve Mader, supervisors Rhonda Helgeson and Thomas Jacobs, clerk Lois Meinking and treasurer Mary Leuck. Chairman Mader called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag was made. The clerk read the minutes from the meetings held August 10 and 24. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve the minutes. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. The motion passed. The treasurer gave the monthly financial report. Rhonda Helgeson made the motion to approve the report. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. The motion passed.

The road report and maintenance was discussed. Culverts for Schams Ave. and Wuensch Rd. will arrive at the end of the month. Hess Road, Kreibich Coulee and Elizabeth Way were discussed. Trees planted in the Lost Ridge Addition were discussed.

The park report and seal coating of tennis courts was put on hold as the Lions Club meets tonight and is considering assisting with the project.

The recycling report was given. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve the cooperative agreement for the joint publication of the newsletter. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. The motion passed.

The Comprehensive plan update was discussed as a meeting will be held September 26 at 7:30 P.M. at the Hamilton Town Hall. Zoning change issues were discussed and the meetings announced to be held September 20 (county) and 22 (fairgrounds). Complaints on the ATV track at the Early property were discussed including the removal of the track.

Mobile home court licenses were discussed. Steve Mader made the motion to approve licenses provided fees are kept up to date. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Signage for open carry law at town buildings was postponed until October.

Based upon the Wisconsin Towns Association model and Wisconsin Act 10 a resolution to adopt an employee grievance procedure was discussed. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve the procedure and Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. The motion passed.

The census reports a population of 2060. Chairman Steve Mader is looking into the validity as this seems high.

A motion was made by Tom Jacobs to appoint Ken Hess as Commissioner to the St. Joseph's Sanitary District #1 Board. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion and the motion passed. It is a 6 year term.

Fire fee ordinance will be discussed next month.

The Blood Center of Wisconsin Blood Drive will be held Monday, October 10, 2011 2:00-7:00 P.M. at the Community Center (Town Hall).

Monthly accounts were paid.

Tom Jacobs made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. Motion passed.
