Minutes Town Board Meeting May 9, 2012**

Chairman Steve Mader called the meeting to order. Supervisor Thomas Jacobs was present. Supervisor Rhonda Helgeson was excused. Clerk Lois Meinking and Treasurer Mary Leuck were present. The Pledge of Allegiance was said. The clerk read the minutes of the April 11 meeting. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve the minutes. Steve Mader seconded the motion. The motion passed. The treasurer gave the treasurer's report. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve the report. Steve Mader seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Steve Mader made a motion to approve liquor licenses for Bahr's Ridge and St. Joe's Country Market. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Schmaltz road improvements were discussed regarding drainage and erosion. Tom and Rita Sanger were at the meeting. There had been discussion with the La Crosse County Land Conservation Department. Tom Jacobs made a motion to postpone action until the June meeting. Steve Mader seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Steve Mader made a motion to accept the contract with the Town of Shelby Fire Department. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. The motion passed. An AED has been ordered for the hall which includes patches for use on children. Tom Jacobs attended training and has been working on updating the Emergency Management Plan.

Jim Rasmussen was present on behalf of the Valleywood Springs Homeowner Association. Covenants related to the Werner property were discussed. There is concern about the bridge and dumping. Steve Mader made a motion to meet with the county and legal counsel to inspect the property and certify a letter demanding compliance within 45 days. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. The motion passed.

The road report was reviewed. Schams Avenue will be seeded and residents will have an opportunity for a culvert. Kirchner Construction volunteered to pay for damages to Elizabeth Way. Steve Mader made a motion to bill them \$550 and Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed.

The recycling Center was reviewed. The brush will be pushed back on the Koenig property and the area collecting water will be filled and leveled. The center needs gravel near the compactor and the gate post needs to be fixed. Pot holes need to be filled in at the hall.

Steve Mader and Tom Jacobs attended the Lions Club Meeting. The next project will be to replace the wooden steps. They are considering improved lighting in the restrooms and applying for a grant from Menards.

The election report was given. There were 446 voters. Scott Walker received 41%; Kathleen Falk received 24%; Tom Barrett received 29%.

Tom Jacobs made a motion to amend ordinance #26 to include Coon Creek Firefighter Association and not charging in excess of bills. Steve Mader seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Steve Mader made a motion for Open Book to be held June 13th 3:00-5:00 p.m. with Board of Review 5:00-7:00 p.m. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Bids for road repairs will be opened June 13th at 2:30 p.m.

Citizen comments: Strong Seniors exercise class June 19 - Aug. 30 (9:00 – 10:00 a.m.); Blood Drive June 6th 2:00-7:00 p.m.; CPR-AED training for Toddle Inn will not be charged as it is a service to the community; it was suggested that vehicle tags/decals should be considered for the recycling center due to non-residential use; Firefighters were complimented for selling chicken Q tickets door-to-door; Francis Le Jeune discussed plans for a garage; Schams Ave. culvert apron was discussed.

Bills were paid.

Tom Jacobs made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Steve Mader seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned.
