Minutes Town Board Meeting June 13, 2012

Chairman Steve Mader called the meeting to order. Supervisor Rhonda Helgeson was present. Supervisor Thomas Jacobs was excused. Clerk Lois Meinking and Treasurer Mary Leuck were present. The Pledge of Allegiance was said. The clerk read the minutes of the May 9 meeting. Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to approve the minutes. Steve Mader seconded the motion. The motion passed. The treasurer gave the treasurer's report. Rhonda made a motion to approve the report. Steve Mader seconded the motion. The motion passed.

The election report was given: 994 voters for the Governor/Lt. Gov. Recall Election; 48% voter turn-out (12% Absentee Voters). 57% Walker/42% Barrett; 57%; Kleefisch/43% Mahlum. Thanks to the election workers.

An AED/CPR presentation was provided by Sara Bergstrom from Tri-State and Shelby Fire Department. The AED at the hall includes adult and child pads.

The Sanger property was reviewed as the engineering is complete and cost will need to be considered. Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to send a letter to Rita and Tom Sanger informing them that the project is postponed until the Town hears from them and they offer to pay 1/3 of the cost. Steve Mader seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Road bids were received at 2:30 PM and reviewed for Schams Ave., Kreibich Coulee, Malzacher, Berg, and Lemke. Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to accept the bids from Scott Construction. Steve Mader seconded the motion. The motion passed. The bid was awarded to Scott Construction (Paul Simons) not to exceed \$66,000 at this time. A preliminary meeting will be scheduled for the 20th/21st so they can start sooner than later.

The mowing/road report was given. The mower is working now with a goal to cut and take care of noxious weeds by June 29. The broken guard rail on Ober Rd. will be addressed. Road workers asked to adjust hours this summer since only one person can be on the mower at a time.

No Park Report.

Recycling Center report was given. The post was fixed at the center. Neale Koenig property was reviewed regarding leveling with fill and pushing back brush. This would give the center more space and alleviate a water concern on the property. A small caterpillar and dozer will be used.

Citizen Comments: Please notify the neighbors on Schams Ave. in advance of the project so they have ample time to think about what they need. Corrugated metal pipe is preferred. A culvert will be discussed with Scott Construction (Hess). Residents may want to have work done on driveways and purchase culverts. Assessor's contract will be on the July agenda with a goal to stay within 95% valuation of the township.

Bills were paid.

Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Steve Mader seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned.
