December 12, 2012 Board Meeting Minutes

Chairman, Steve Mader called the meeting to order. Supervisor Tom Jacobs was present. Supervisor Rhonda Helgeson was excused. Clerk Lois Meinking and Treasurer Mary Leuck were present. The Pledge of Allegiance was said. The clerk read the minutes of the November meeting. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve the regular meeting and Budget Levy meeting minutes. Steve Mader seconded the motion. The motion passed. The Treasurer gave the financial report. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve the report. Steve Mader seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Troy Gunderson, Superintendent of the West Salem School District presented information about the district. He provided the annual report and information from the Taxpayers Alliance of interest to the Town. The SchoolFacts12 CESA 4 Customized Report was shared for district comparison.

Discussion was held regarding the adoption of the new La Crosse County Comprehensive Zoning. Steve Mader made a motion to approve Resolution 2012-2 to adopt the County Comprehensive Zoning. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. The motion passed 2-0.

Zoning issues and a sign request on CTH FO (Zitzman) were discussed. Robert Robek requested Sunnyslope Drive be seal coated in 2013 as the road is in need of repair.

Steve Mader reported that the annual road report was submitted to the state prior to the December 15 deadline. It reflected more updated roads compared to the previous 2 years.

There was discussion on Fire Numbers for Valley Wood Springs. They have been completed. The crew was directed to order more posts for Meadow Ridge, Lost Ridge and other areas. Signs will be ordered with the new reflectivity standards. They will be installed weather permitting.

A motion was made by Tom Jacobs to approve a 6 month mobile home permit for Marie Strangstalien. Steve Mader seconded the motion. Motion passed.

The Recycler has been ordered for 2013 and will be ready and mailed to residences and businesses this month. The 2013 Recycler includes information that the county does not charge for E-waste but the Town does.

Citizen Comments were received. Local resident near the CTH OA project, Jean Klos presented information on the new County Highway OA reconstruction. The Town of Greenfield had been given no information about the old section to be abandoned. Discussion was that the Town would not take the road over until the road was properly resurfaced. The tires for the plow were ordered November 14 but have not been replaced to date.

Bills were paid.

Tom Jacobs made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Steve Mader seconded the motion. Meeting was adjourned.

The next meeting is January 9, 2013. Tax bills have been mailed out with information about paying in person at the hall and where to mail payments.
