January 9, 2013 Board Meeting Minutes

Chairman Steve Mader called the meeting to order. Supervisors Rhonda Helgeson and Tom Jacobs were present. Clerk Lois Meinking and Treasurer Mary Leuck were present. The Pledge of Allegiance was said. The Clerk read the minutes of the December 12 meeting. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve the minutes. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. The motion passed. The treasurer gave the financial report. Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to approve the report. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Plowing was discussed. The power steering on one truck is being fixed at St. Joseph Equipment. There were some complaints on Lost Ridge and Bina Rd. There is a 66 foot right of way.

The assessor made an error on the property owned by Thomas & Lois Meinking. 24 acres placed in Managed Forest Land for 25 years were put in the tax parcel belonging to Kenneth Meinking. Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to have the assessor correct the mistake within 7 business days and have the treasurer issue new tax bills to the appropriate land owners. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed.

The first payment for the assessor, Charlotte Johnson for 2013 (\$3250) was discussed. Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to withhold payment until the February meeting to see that the Meinking property error is fixed and if any penalties are needed. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. The motion passed.

The annual meeting is scheduled for April 16, 2013. The road inspection is scheduled for March 22 at noon.

The Primary election will be February 19th and Spring election April 2nd. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve additional election inspectors: Jill Murphy and Philip Murray. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Loss of funding for Strittmater Road improvements through the TRIP program was discussed. In 2008 the Town applied for \$175,000 stimulus dollars which needed to be matched by the Town for \$175,000 to repair the road. Since the Town funds were not available the funding was lost. If future funding opportunities are available effort will be made to apply.

Citizen comments were made about Bina Road. The Webers have been residents for 7 years. Each year they dismantle fences and put up T posts and they still receive damage from plowing. There is concern about a damaged culvert (driveway). The Town of Washington plows the road as the Town of Greenfield plows Evans Dwyer. The Board will review this on the road inspection and bring this to the attention of the Town of Washington Chairman, Dan Korn.

Steve Mader made a motion to adjourn to pay bills. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned. The next meeting is February 13, 2013. The WTA meeting for officers will be held Saturday, February 23rd.
