April 10, 2013 Board Meeting Minutes

Chairman Steve Mader called the meeting to order. Supervisors Rhonda Helgeson and Tom Jacobs were present Clerk Lois Meinking and Treasurer Mary Leuck were present. The Pledge of Allegiance was said. The clerk read the minutes of the March 13, 2013 meeting. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve the minutes. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. The motion passed. The treasurer gave the March financial report. Tom Jacobs made a motion to accept the report. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. The motion passed.

La Crosse County Highway Commissioner Ron Chamberlain gave a report on the CTH OA reconstruction project that will take place May-September. Bids went to St. Joseph Construction. The county is willing to work with the Town if reasonable about purchasing the old road. The highway is open to local traffic only (\$180 fine). Bus turnarounds need to be considered.

The election and WTA meeting reports were given. Tom Jacobs and Rhonda Helgeson will attend Board of Review Training in Tomah April 18th. Members of BOR need certification every two years.

Tim Wuebben presented a conditional use permit off CTH M for a single family home. Steve made a motion to approve rezoning provided a road maintenance agreement for easement access is in place. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Mobile home court fees are in arrears. \$9337.50 was received. The balance will be sent to the Town in May. Steve Mader made a motion to revise the mobile home ordinance. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. The motion passed. The revision will include a penalty for late payments.

The road and equipment reports were given. The road inspection is April 12th. The following roads were discussed: Breidel Coulee Rd., Schams Ave., Schieche Rd., Strittmater Rd., Sunny Slope, Beier Rd., Birchview Circle, Ten Mile and the Valleywood Springs culvert.

The recycling center summer hours are Tuesdays 4:00-7:00 P.M. and Saturdays 8:00-1:00 P.M.

The Coon Creek Fire Fighter Association dues were discussed. Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to pay the base fee as in previous years. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. The motion passed.

The Town newsletter was mailed today.
