Chairman Steve Mader called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance. Supervisors Rhonda Helgeson and Tom Jacobs were present. Clerk Lois Meinking and Treasurer Mary Leuck were present. The clerk read the minutes of the June 12, 2013 meeting. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve the minutes as amended. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. Motion passed. The treasurer gave the financial report for June. Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to approve the report. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed.

There was discussion on a zoning change at W3063 Kreibich Coulee Road for the Vandezande property. Gwen was present and explained while they have lived there 9 years as residential the property was zoned Ag A. The county notified them and charged a fee for changing to rural (former residential category). Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to accept the zoning change from Ag to rural. Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to contact the DOR about the Samuel Morris property and send a letter to pay the taxes until it is resolved. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Citizen comments included a thank you and appreciation to the Kirschbaum and Wiedemann families for the fireworks and picnic at the park celebrating Independence Day. Strong Seniors classes are beginning. Sample window tags were shared for possible use at the recycling center. The wall near the play equipment has a gap which could be dangerous. Steve Mader will inform the Lions Club.

Tom Jacobs made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned to pay bills and hold the closed session.
