August 14, 2013 Board Meeting Minutes

Chairman Steve Mader called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance. Supervisors Rhonda Helgeson and Tom Jacobs were present. Clerk Lois Meinking and Treasurer Mary Leuck were present. The clerk read the minutes of the July 10 regular meeting and July 17 and 24 special meetings. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve the minutes. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. Motion passed. The treasurer gave the financial report for July. Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to approve the report. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed.

There was discussion about the name change of road for 3 parcels from Hess Rd. to Sunnyslope Drive. The county land use specialist notified the owners and new fire numbers were ordered.

Tom Jacobs made a motion to schedule a special meeting August 28th at 2:30 p.m. to discuss the petition by Andrew and Karina Siebenaler to enter their residential property into the St. Joseph Sanitary District #1. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. Motion passed.

There was discussion of an event by a Garden Club at Deep Roots Community Farm on CTY RD YY September 14-15. Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to approve the Class B license. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed.

There was a proposal for a Conditional Use Permit by Krause-Nururdin for parking a food service truck (The Grill Spot). Tami explained there would be no deliveries or sales there. Steve Mader made a motion to approve the CUP on the condition it is parked out of sight. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed.

The road report was discussed. Tom Jacobs made a motion to sealcoat Sunnyslope Drive. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. Motion passed. The CTH OA project was discussed. The Town of Barre will be contacted. There is consideration of taking over the road once inspected. If taken over it would be named Casa de sol Road as requested by long-time resident. There was a request to push snow to the right of the granary on Christianson Road. A letter will be sent to Kirchner that the road will be repaired and they will be billed due to road damage.

The recycling report was given. Tom Ludwigson reported on the DNR inspection of e-cycling and the need for signs. Appliances need to be removed. The exit gate needs repair and the brush needs to be burned. Tom Jacobs made a motion to order recycling permit identification hang tags and decals for residents. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Assessor proposals were reviewed. Three firms will be contacted for interviews on August 28th.

Complaints regarding loose dogs on Clements Road were discussed. Residents with concern should contact the Coulee Region Humane Society.

Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to reappoint Larry Sebranek to a 6 year term as commissioner for the St. Joseph Sanitary District #1. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Citizen comments were made. A public thank you was made to the first responders especially Kevin Timm. For future consideration surfacing the parking lot should be priced out. There was concern about a home for sale on Schams. There will be a new bridge on CTH M in the future. The preliminary estimated population of the town is 2,084.

The Wisconsin Towns Association is meeting at the park on August 22 at 6:30 p.m.

The Board of Review will reconvene August 28th at 3:00 p.m.

Tom Jacobs made a motion to adjourn to pay bills. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. Meeting was adjourned.
