Minutes of Board Meeting December 11, 2013

The refuse and recycling bids were posted and sent out. Proposals will be opened and reviewed at the January 8, 2014 meeting for a 3-year contract.

Recycling center vehicle permits were discussed. Hang tags and Mylar decals (\$5) will be sold to residents when paying tax bills, at meetings, and will be available at the recycling center. A target date for required usage is February 1, 2014.

Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Chairman Mader gave an update on filing the Wisconsin Department of Transportation report. The road report was reviewed. Darrel reported new blades are needed for the plow.
