Minutes of Board Meeting January 8, 2014

Chairman Steve Mader called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance. Supervisors Tom Jacobs and Rhonda Helgeson were present. The clerk and treasurer, Lois Meinking and Mary Leuck were present respectively. The clerk read the minutes of the December 11 meeting. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve the minutes as read. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. Motion passed. The treasurer gave the financial report for December. Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to approve the report. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Chairman Mader read the proposals for refuse and recycling from Harter's Quick Clean-Up, Hilltopper Refuse & Recycling, Southwest Sanitation, LLC, and Waste Management. The Board postponed action for 30 days.

Recycling Center tags & Mylar window decals (\$5) should be purchased by February 1. Recycling center employees requesting clothing allowance need to provide receipts for reimbursement.

Vernon Electric has provided service to the old town hall which is not in use. The Board considered idle service costs to keep the meter or disconnect. Tom Jacobs made the motion to discontinue service. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Titan Machinery new sign appeal was denied at the county level. To Increase the height of the sign was not in compliance. The town is considering a sign ordinance. Chuck Schams presented information from the meeting. The Board will review County Zoning the Town adopted.

Road Plowing & Sanding report. There was discussion on the new blades needed on the plow. They should be ordered right away.

Carl Johnson requested reconsideration of a guardrail on the west side at the Lost Ridge entrance. It is duly noted Carl sent a survey and 33 residents responded to his email asking for support for a guard rail. Another area of concern is near the log cabin. Brad Mannstedt living there 14 years discussed the east side of Strittmater Rd. There is a ditch which Brad requested 3 feet of it be used to widen the road. The Board will review the concern. Request was to stripe it due to fog concerns. According to the survey many residents think it should be 25 MPH rather than 35 MPH. The Board will meet with Carl at April road inspection to seek a solution.

The Annual Meeting is scheduled for April 22nd. WTA meeting February 15 at Fox Hollow.

Citizen Comments: Primary Election February 18 for the Westby Area School District School Board.

Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to adjourn to pay bills. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned.
