Minutes of Board Meeting February 12, 2014

Chairman Steve Mader called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance. Supervisors Rhonda Helgeson and Tom Jacobs were present. The Clerk and Treasurer Lois Meinking and Mary Leuck were present respectively. The clerk read the minutes of the January 8, 2014 meeting. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve the minutes. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. Motion passed. The treasurer gave the financial report for January. Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to approve the report. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Recycling Proposals were reviewed and discussed. Harter's Quick Clean-up & Hilltopper Refuse & Recycling representatives were present. Steve Mader made a motion to accept the proposal from Hilltopper Refuse & Recycling for a 3 year contract. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. Single stream and #3-7 plastic were discussed. Newspaper and fiber were discussed. Rhonda Helgeson removed her second to the motion. Steve Mader rescinded the motion. Tom Jacobs made a motion to postpone discussion to the March Board Meeting. Steve Mader seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

The Recycling Center report was given. If the schools are closed on Tuesdays due to weather in winter the Recycling Center will be closed. The center is open Saturdays 8:00 A.M.-1:00 P.M. year round. This will be on the agenda in March. Tags and decals are available at the hall as well as the recycling center and treasurer's home.

The sign ordinance will be discussed at the March and April meetings.

Spring road inspection date will be set at the March meeting. Fire numbers and the Dead End sign on Schieche Rd. need replacement. There will be a plan for sign reflectivity compliance in June.

Sanding/Salt was discussed. The brakes on the plow needed to be fixed.

Clements Road Maintenance agreement renewal was brought up. Al Radke spoke about the agreement from when the Mlsna home was built (9 mos.). An agreement was adopted like another resident had. The Town has a copy of. It will be on the March agenda with Al Radke invited.

Wisconsin Towns Association meeting February 15<sup>th</sup> featuring Board of Review Training. Chairman and clerk will attend and renew Board of Review Affidavit.

The annual meeting will be held Tuesday, April 22 at 7:00 P.M. The newsletter will be sent prior.

It will be on the March agenda with discussion of a driveway permit and possible need for a culvert.
