Minutes Board Meeting March 12, 2014

Chairman Steve Mader called the meeting to order with the pledge of allegiance. Supervisor Rhonda Helgeson was present. Supervisor Tom Jacobs arrived late. Clerk Lois Meinking and Treasurer Mary Leuck were present respectively. The Clerk read the minutes of the February 12, 2014 meeting. Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to approve the minutes. Steve Mader seconded the motion. Motion passed.

West Salem School District Superintendent Troy Gunderson provided information on the referendum questions for the Spring Election April 1, 2014. Diagrams, renderings, and a map of district property were presented. Residents asked questions and discussed the 2 questions. If residents have questions they may contact him and/or locate further information on the website.

Recycling Center report was given. Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to close the center on the weekday if the La Crosse School District is closed due to weather. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Zoning issues were discussed. Lot layout and road agreement for land for sale by Al Bushek was discussed. County zoning meeting was discussed. Zoning items were discussed regarding the La Crosse County Meeting to be held Monday, March 31, 2014 at 6:30 P.M. in the Administrative Center Board Room.

Road weight ban/embargo was discussed. Tom Jacobs made a motion to begin the road ban March 17, 2014. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. Motion passed. Missing posts on Kreibich Coulee Road since floods 2007/2008 were discussed and will be reviewed at road inspection. Road Inspection is scheduled Wednesday, April 9, 2014 at 1:00 P.M. A volunteer engineer in the community offered to assist. Several roads were mentioned and will be reviewed by the Board.

Casa Del Sol Road (Old CTH OA) agreement was discussed. The Town of Barre took action at their meeting March 11, 2014. Chairman Mader requested a survey for the legal description and a signed contract from Barre. The county legal description from Old CTH OA was provided.

Recycling proposals were discussed with a review of the comparison bids of Harter's Quick Clean-Up and Hilltopper Refuse & Recycling Service Inc. The addendum from Harter's Quick Clean-Up was read into the record. The single stream method of recycling was discussed. Steve Mader made a motion to award the contract to Hilltopper Refuse & Recycling Service Inc. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed. Single stream recycling was provided as an option. It will be discussed at the annual meeting on April 22.

The new Fire Protection Service Agreement with the Shelby Fire Department was discussed. Tom Jacobs made a motion to accept the contract April 1, 2014-March 31, 2016. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. Motion passed. Bills are paid biannually April and October.

Request from St. Joseph Ridge Parish for driveway permit onto Town Hall Road was tabled as no one was present.

The road plowing and sanding report was given. There was discussion on Elizabeth Way, Hickory Terrace. The 66 foot right-of-way was reviewed. Snow pushed back to make room for next storm. Machinery expenses and sand/salt have impacted the budget.

Annual Meeting date will be posted for April 22, 2014 at 7:00 P.M. at the Town Hall. Newsletter plan was discussed for April delivery.

May 13, 2014 - Open Book 4:00-6:00 P.M. with Assessor (Associated Appraisal) field work beginning on properties this week.

June 4, 2014 - Board of Review 6:00-8:00 P.M.

Citizen Comments: Michelle Hundt requested use of Town Hall for Yoga Class one morning (9:30 A.M.) and evening per week (5:45 P.M.) Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to allow Yoga classes for \$20 per month. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed. DOT meeting about State HWY 33 is scheduled March 25 7:00 A.M. - 9:00 P.M.

Steve Mader made a motion to adjourn the meeting to pay bills. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed.
