Regular Board Meeting Minutes August 13, 2014

Chairman Steve Mader called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. at the Town Hall with the Pledge of Allegiance. Supervisors Rhonda Helgeson and Tom Jacobs were present. Clerk and Treasurer Lois Meinking and Mary Leuck were present respectively. The clerk read the minutes of the July 9, 2014 meeting. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve the minutes. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. Motion passed. Minutes of the hearing on Casa Del Sol Rd. were read. Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to approve the minutes. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed. The treasurer provided the financial report for July. Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to approve the report. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Election Results for the August Fall-Partisan Primary were presented with a 10 % turnout. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve Mary Papenfuss as an election inspector through December 31, 2015. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. Motion passed. There was a shortage of poll workers. Workers may be approved from within the county. Other changes to the law were presented.

Park Report was presented with discussion on road edge.

Recycle Report was given. The crew was requested to move appliances and tires. Chris Blegen subbed this week.

Picnic Licenses were requested for Fall Festival on the Farm Non-profit "Grow Your Brain" CTH YY on Sept. 6. Ana Skemp presented the request. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve the license. Rhonda Helgeson seconded the motion. Motion passed. St. Joe's Church for Fall Chicken Q requested a license for Sept. 7 presented by Cari Servais. Rhonda Helgeson made a motion to approve the picnic license. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Road projects update was given: CTH M & Schams; Rip rap on Schams; patch area by mailboxes at Brookview; culvert on Kreibich Coulee (emergency patch); Highland Dr. strategy @30 ft. long; Beier Road progress and gravel on Johnson.

Todd & Emily Wolters (788-1946) were present. Todd is managing Brookview and Golden Valley mobile home court. Park wide meet and greet August 30th. Questions on large item pick up were referred to recycling brochure and the need to purchase \$5 recycling permits. Carports were discussed. Building permits are needed. Todd and residents can check ordinance and with Chad Vandenberg at La Crosse County.

Sally Lindahl was present from the CFFFA to resolve the 2013 bill and discuss rates, fees, and contracts. The 2015 contract is changing and they are using a 4 year rolling average. The billing will be quarterly. Effective January 2015 the Association will change the name to: Coon Creek Fire Commission Tom Jacobs made a motion to pay \$500 of a bill. Steve Mader seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Sign ordinance was distributed to review and is also on the web.

Anne Loomis of the La Crosse County Historical Commission was present. What is the plan? She shared ideas and citizen photos were discussed. For consideration the dates of significance 1894 and 2014 were reviewed and consideration of an etching of the building, flower/garden path at the location of the old hall at CTH M & NN was given. Donations and time in-kind from an architect may be considered.

Citizen Comments: 4-H Sign on hold they meet at hall 1st Sunday of the month; Concern about Elizabeth Way; Consideration for putting ordinances on-line. Some were revised years ago (could be scanned).
