

Town of Greenfield
La Crosse County, Wisconsin
Regular Board Meeting
Minutes March 11, 2015

Chairman Steve Mader called the meeting to order at 7:01 P.M. at the Greenfield Town Hall at N1800 Town Hall Rd. La Crosse, WI 54601 with the Pledge of Allegiance. Supervisor Tom Jacobs was present. Supervisor Rhonda Helgeson was excused. Clerk and Treasurer Lois Meinking and Mary Leuck were present respectively. The clerk read the minutes of the February 11, 2015 meeting. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve the minutes. Steve Mader seconded the motion. Motion passed. At the February Primary election Gloria Doyle (56) and Brian Barton (27) advanced to the Spring Election on April 7 for Circuit Court Judge Branch 5 (Tlustosch 38). Andrew Lipski (2) and Eric Thunstedt (2) advanced to the Spring Election for Westby School Board Seat #5 (Henderson 2). The treasurer presented the financial report for February. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve the report. Steve Mader seconded the motion. Motion passed. The bill from Scott Construction was reviewed.

Chairman Mader gave the road report. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve Road Bans beginning March 16, 2015 at 7:00 A.M. with seasonal weight restrictions for 6 weeks. Steve Mader seconded the motion. Motion passed. AECOM Engineers will be on site the week of March 16th to inspect Town salt shed. The county highway commissioner has assured Tom and Steve that there would be a paved shoulder sufficient for paths at the bridge on CTH M. Tom Jacobs made a motion to follow the county plan. Tom Jacobs withdrew his motion with consideration to defer and review the original plan and code. It will be discussed at April 8th meeting. The Annual meeting is April 21. Road Inspection time/date is 2:00 P.M. on April 17th.

Tony & Crystal Becker CTMM 6-709-0 presented a request for shared driveway. Easement was discussed. Becker's estimate it is a 12 foot road. Is county zoning okay with proposal? Discussion was held about driving through someone else's property. Town will need a description. Access for emergency vehicles and turn-around was discussed. This will be on April agenda in. Crystal contacted Scott Custer, Kurt in Land conservation and Dave for well, health and sanitation

Kevin Burnett-W4050 State RD 33 is planning for 12' X 20' outbuilding. He was referred to County zoning and then the building inspector. Town officials see no issues with the number of acres he owns.

Sullivan property on Tower Lane was postponed as they were not present. Clements Road concern about condition of road was discussed and an agreement. 4 residents reviewed history with the Board and September 10, 2012 documentation. The 66 foot easement and 9 inches of gravel were reviewed. Board may look at agreement and defer to Town attorney. Discuss with owner about adding gravel and a turn-around at end. It is a private matter. Residents should check their agreement copy with their attorneys as there are no easy answers regarding private roads.

A temporary liquor license (Picnic) was issued to St. Joseph Ridge Catholic Church for their Chicken dinner March 29th 3-7 P.M.

Motion was made by Tom Jacobs seconded by Steve Mader to endorse the WTA resolution opposing municipal assessment turning over local control to county . Resolution No. 2015-02 was read into the record.

Citizen Comments: Board of Review sample ordinance will be on the April agenda to establish procedures and criteria for allowing alternative forms of sworn testimony at BOR hearings. Revised objection forms have been provided by the Department of Revenue. The Fire Department Chicken Q is Sunday at 2:00 P.M. in the Town of Shelby. Additional election inspectors were approved: Rose Puma, Clarice Kammel, and Gary Puma through December 31, 2015. State budget was discussed.

Steve Mader made a motion to adjourn and pay bills at 8:07 P.M. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Meeting adjourned.
