Minutes Annual Meeting  
April 21, 2015

Chairman Mader called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. at the Town Hall N1800 Town Hall Rd., La Crosse, WI with the Pledge of Allegiance. Chairman, Steve Mader, Supervisors Thomas Jacobs and Brandon Wright, Clerk Lois Meinking and Treasurer Mary Leuck were given official oaths of office. The clerk read the minutes of the 2014 meeting into the record. The clerk presented the annual report of expenditures and receipts. Barry Nelson made a motion to approve the 2014 annual report. Dave Hansen seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Daren Schieldt presented the Shelby fire department report. He discussed training and calls. He also discussed burn permits.

Equipment report was discussed. Couple tires are needed on mower.

Road inspection and report was discussed. Tom Jacobs made a motion for a continuing resolution for the Town Board to borrow up to \$90,000 per year repaid annually in each of the next 3 years to repair roads. Barry Nelson seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. There was discussion of blacktopping the Town Hall Road and parking area. Darren Schieldt made an advisory motion to get bids on blacktopping the Town Hall area. Brandon Wright seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Recycling report was given. They are requesting to enlarge the office area and paving a circle. This will not be in the budget this year.

Consideration was given for an ordinance for violating road bans.

Tennis courts were discussed. The park shelter needs general clean up.

Proposed wage increases were discussed by Steve Mader. They would not take effect until the next term of office (2017). Steve Mader made a motion to raise the clerk and treasurer salary to \$7200. Steve Mader amended his motion to add an increase to the supervisors and chairman by 5%. Nancy Kroner seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Dave Hansen made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:34 P.M. Nancy Kroner seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
