Regular Board Meeting
Minutes May 13, 2015

Chairman Steve Mader called the meeting to order May 13, 2015 with the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:00 P.M. at the Town of Greenfield Hall N1800 Town Hall Rd., La Crosse, WI 54601. Supervisor Brandon Wright was present. Supervisor Tom Jacobs was excused. Clerk Lois Meinking and Treasurer Mary Leuck were present. The clerk read the minutes of the April 8, 2015 regular meeting. Steve Mader made a motion to approve the minutes as corrected. Brandon Wright seconded the motion. Motion passed. The minutes of the Annual Meeting April 21, 2015 were read into the record. Recycling information was sent to the clerk May 12. The grant is reduced compared to previous years across the state. The Treasurer gave the report for April. Brandon Wright made a motion to approve the report. Steve Mader seconded the motion. Motion passed. Chairman Mader discussed the need to purchase an additional computer. The discussion of Windows 8 compatibility and training were discussed.

Park Report regarding mowing was given by Chairman Mader.

Recycling Center Report was given by Tom Ludwigson. Dale Jacobson was hired as fourth recycling engineer. The Board would like to see a plan for what the recycling engineers are interested in for extending office area. It will be on June 10 agenda (estimate/plan).

On May 11 there were 51 donors at the Blood Drive. 109 % of the goal was met. Next Blood Drive is October 12th.

Road report included consideration of culverts on Meadow Ridge, Ridgeview & Hess intersection, Nick Servais, and Blegens'. Bids will be read at the June 10th meeting. Schmaltz Road (Bid 2014 awarded to Custom Excavating); Meadow Ridge (1997); Kammel Coulee, Molién Rd., Berg, Town Hall Rd., and stone for Johnson Rd. The road inspection from April will be reviewed.

Board of Review is June 9th 4-6 P.M. at the Town Hall. Appointments may be made with the clerk. The assessor reminded the Town that finishing a basement is to be reported. Assessment questions should be directed to the assessor (year round) at 800-721-4157
