Minutes August 12, 2015
Regular Board Meeting

Chairman Mader called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:00 P.M. at the Town Hall N1800 Town Hall Rd., La Crosse, WI. Supervisors Tom Jacobs and Brandon Wright were present. Treasurer Mary Leuck was present. Clerk Lois Meinking was present. The clerk read the minutes of the July 8, 2015 meeting. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve the minutes. Brandon Wright seconded the motion. Motion passed. The treasurer gave the financial report for July. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve the report. Brandon Wright seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Park and mowing report was given by chairman. Some work needs to be done at park (erosion).

County Recycle grant agreement was discussed. Steve Mader made motion to approve the county recycling agreement as discussed. Brandon Wright seconded the motion. Motion passed. Recycling Center will be closed December 24, **2016** and open December 31, **2016**. Concern about medical supplies at center and signs needed.

Road report was given. CTH M and Schams semi concern since it was fixed. Consider putting posts there. Town Hall Road and lot look good. Stark Road and Kloss Road culverts were put in. Rings were put in on Schams. Several road signs are needed. Estimate will be checked on for guard rail at Breidel Coulee Bridge. Arch culvert on Schmaltz Road was discussed and tuck pointing considered.

Resolution to borrow \$90,000.00 for current road repairs from First National Bank payable up to 6 months was discussed. Brandon Wright made a motion for a resolution to borrow \$90,000 for current road repairs from First National Bank payable for up to 6 months. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Discussion was held to approve an ordinance on condemnation for building and dwellings on private land that are deemed a public nuisance if they are dangerous, unsafe, or dilapidated. Remedies and recovering costs need to be looked into. Brandon Wright made a motion to defer the ordinance. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Citizen Comments: The DOT will be called about CTH M and State Road 33 complaints from residents; Contact Shelby about stencil machine for painting lines on lot; request to split lot 85 at Ridgeview Heights between 2 neighbors; thank St. Joseph Equipment for storing fire truck during road construction.

Steve Mader made a motion to adjourn to pay bills at 8:04 P.M. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned.
