Minutes October 14, 2015
Regular Board Meeting

Chairman Mader called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. at N1800 Town Hall Rd., La Crosse, WI with the Pledge of Allegiance. Supervisors Tom Jacobs and Brandon Wright were present. Treasurer Mary Leuck was present. Clerk Lois Meinking was present. The minutes of the September 9, 2015 were read by the clerk. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve the minutes as corrected. Brandon Wright seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. The treasurer gave the financial report for September. Tom Jacobs made a motion to approve the financial report as read. Brandon Wright seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. Payment to Scott Construction was discussed as they will complete project next week and will be paid the full amount.

Truck & mower repairs and bills were discussed.

Zoning issues were discussed. Covenants in Servais Terrace addition were discussed regarding installing a fence. Request was made to mail covenants to residents. Cell Tower in Shelby report was given. The split of Lot 85 in Ridgeview request was withdrawn. Conditions from the county for Coulee Region Modelers, Inc. were reviewed.

Road projects were discussed. A culvert in East Hills was discussed and is being planned to divert water to east side. Schmaltz Road arch culvert replacement was discussed. Barbara Kooiman of the La Crosse County Historic Sites Preservation Commission was present. She discussed the history (145 years) of the arch which was recognized as an historic site. Discussion of a plan was presented and reviewed.

Levy Limit worksheet was discussed. Steve Mader made a motion to pass a resolution to propose exceeding the existing levy limit by \$14,094 to \$405,000. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion approved unanimously. Budget Hearing & Levy Limit Meeting is Nov 16 at 7:00 P.M. Budget meeting October 30th at 2:00 P.M.

Implements of Husbandry will be discussed at next meeting. Review the WTA information.

Public Nuisance ordinance was postponed.

Park Shelter needs to be winterized.

Recycle Center was discussed. Appliances need to be hauled.

Citizen Comments: Dave Brown was present from the Fire Department. There are concerns about the air compressor in the shop and wiring. End of Servais Colleran is a concern. Strong Seniors class is full. Handicapped lines need to be painted. Blood Drive had 44 donors. WTA meeting Nov. 19. Schams Avenue and highway concern.

Steve Mader made a motion to approve the assessor contract for 2016-2018. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Brandon Wright made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:36 P.M. to pay bills. Tom Jacobs seconded the motion. Meeting adjourned.
