

Town of Greenfield, La Crosse County, Wisconsin
Regular Board Meeting
Minutes February 10, 2016

Chairman Mader called the meeting to order at 7:02 P.M. with the Pledge of Allegiance at the Greenfield Town Hall at N1800 Town Hall Rd. La Crosse, WI. Supervisors Tom Jacobs and Brandon Wright were present. Treasurer Mary Leuck was present. Clerk Lois Meinking was present. The clerk read the minutes of the regular meeting January 13, 2016. Motion was made Wright/Jacobs to approve as read. Motion passed unanimously. The treasurer gave the financial report for January 2016. There was discussion to pay off the \$90,000 road repair loan by February 19. Motion made by Mader/Wright to accept the financial report and pay off the outstanding road repair loan at the bank. Motion passed unanimously. The \$20,000 complex loan is due soon, Election notice for Feb.16,2016. Additional election inspectors were approved by the Board. Road report was given with no complaints

The repair of the door at the shop is scheduled. A non-insulated door was put on at the recycling Center. Worker compensation claim was discussed.

Roads were reviewed for bid documents. Scott will be consulted in March Bid document review and further information in March from Scott. The following roads were discussed: JBerg Rd., Cold mix ruts easier, Johnson Rd get price on it, Ober Rd. Heikel Rd. 1109'. cow path Rd., Lorenz Rd. sealcoating not too bad, Christenson Rd gone with logging (may not make the cut this yr.), Kammel Coulee Rd toward spillway (all alligator cracked),round corner near Hess from floods approximately 2500', East HillsDOT Culvert possible, Schmaltz Rd. dig down base on edge solid stone/pave over culvert. Chairman will revamp the list.

Recycling report was given.The addition to the 4' X 6' office is appreciated by recycling engineers for writing checks and warmth. Mattresses and boxsprings (regardless of size) will cost \$15 each to recycle. Job description for custodian was reviewed. Motion by Wright/Jacobs to set wagesat \$15 an hour. Dave Brown assisted with snow removal (front end loader). Discussed wages. Motion made by Mader/Wright to approve \$20 an hour. Motion passed unanimously.

Citizen Comments: Paul Rinzel discussed needing a fire number W3636. He reviewed the erosion issue on Highland. It's been marked for utilities. When are they getting erosion control help?Board discussed the inlet box and need to go under wires and/or go out 100 ft. Mike Hess will look at it to resolve it. Order a new map with Fire numbers. Bill Golden Valley \$175 for 2nd/3rdof February plowing sand/salt. Road crew employees will be on the March agenda. Tree trimming was discussed (Hickory Ln etc.).Shelby Fire chief wanted to know how water tower is doing with subzero temperatures. Sanitary District added the mixture needed. Dilapidated shed reviewed. Chairman will make contact.Bud Raymer was inadvertently paid for 2 permits.

Motion by Wright/Jacobs to adjourn meeting at 7:48 P.M.Meeting was adjourned to pay bills.
