

Town of Greenfield, La Crosse County, Wisconsin
Regular Board Meeting
Minutes March 9, 2016

Chairman Mader called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. with the Pledge of Allegiance at the Greenfield Town Hall at N1800 Town Hall Rd. La Crosse, WI 54601. Supervisors Tom Jacobs and Brandon Wright were present. Treasurer Mary Leuck was present. Clerk Lois Meinking was present. The clerk read the minutes of the regular meeting February 10, 2016. Motion made to approve Wright/Jacobs Motion passed unanimously. The Treasurer gave the February 2016 financial report. Motion made to approve as presented Jacobs/Wright. Motion passed unanimously.

Election report was given by clerk. Results of February Primary: 14% turn out/177 voters. JoAnne F. Kloppenburg 97; Rebecca G. Bradley 67; Joe Donald 12 and approval of additional election inspectors was requested. Motion was made to approve election inspectors Jacobs/Wright. Motion passed 3-0. Election information for April 5 Spring Primary was provided: Presidential preference, Justice of Supreme Court, Court of Appeals Judge, County Supervisor, School District Board contests and referenda questions. Motion made to approve election report Jacobs/Mader. Motion passed 3-0.

Tom Jacobs gave the WTA report. Ordinance enforcement and cell phone policy was discussed as pertaining to Town employees. Information was sent out from the WTA Unit meeting secretary for review.

Charles Norton Superintendent of the Westby Area Schools presented information about the referendum April 5. Background information about the proposed Community Performing Arts Center was presented. Material was shared. Questions were answered.

Recycle Center DNR inspection report from February was reviewed. The DNR will be following up with a letter.

Road report was given. A condo project was started with request to use roads during road ban. Concern that concrete should not be poured during road ban. County Road ban began March 7, 2016. Town ban started in February. Town road ban started in February. Home being built on Shady Pines. Review of road bids. Bids will be turned in by April meeting. Discussed roads needing work this year. Bids will be sent out including alternates for blacktop. Plan to post document. Discussed Meadow Ridge Road and excessive pea gravel solutions with residents present.

Lions Club requested a Picnic license for The Spring Fling April 1, 2016. Motion to approve liquor license Mader/Jacobs. Motion passed unanimously.

The Annual meeting will be held April 19, 2016 at 7:00 P.M. Agenda will be posted 15-20 days prior. Financial report discussed for 2015.

Citizen comments: discussed saving \$15,000 per year for a plow truck. Motion made to set aside \$15,000 for truck replacement for 2015 by Wright/Jacobs. Motion passed 3-0. Batteries/lights were replaced in exit signs, detectors, and carbon monoxide detectors were installed by Bob Hurd. Some batteries are on 2-3 year replacement schedule (manuals provided). Notice: Board is registered to attend WTA Training March 18 for Board of Review at Cranberry Lodge Tomah, WI 8:45 A.M. Tomah. Concern discussed about dogs on Meadow Ridge. Servais Collern subdivision covenants will be mailed out. Burn permits were discussed.

Motion was made to adjourn to closed session at 8:05 P.M. Mader/Wright. Motion passed 3-0.
