Regular Board Meeting
Minutes July 13, 2016

Chairman Mader opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance at N1800 Town Hall Rd. La Crosse, WI. Supervisor Tom Jacobs was present. Treasurer Mary Leuck was present. Clerk Lois Meinking was present. The Clerk read the minutes of the June 8, 2016 meeting. Supervisor Brandon Wright arrived (excused)/ Motion to approve the minutes Jacobs/Wright. Motion passed unanimously. The treasurer gave the financial report for June. Motion to approve report Jacobs/Mader. Motion passed unanimously.

Operator's licenses for beverage sales were discussed. Motion to approve licenses for Kyle Seubert and Cory Krzebietke by Mader/Jacobs. Motion approved 3-0.

Bills were reviewed for tree trimming. Road report was given. Meadow Ridge Road meeting between 2 and 5 PM July 14th with Klaetsch for a second bid. A solution will be reviewed at the August meeting. Mower expense \$4800 as the deck and bearings were worn out.

Rodney Schroeder was present to discuss Appeal No. 2016-24. Soil conservation and zoning reviewed onsite. Jim Roesler shared some history. After the fact variance/permit was discussed. Motion to retain garage constructed within the county right of way Mader/Jacobs. Motion passed unanimously 3-0. Barry Nelson of Planning Commission was present.

Recycle report was given. Tires and appliances have been removed. Additional election inspector Carolyn Zimmermann was discussed. Motion to approve additional election inspector Mader/Wright. Motion passed 3-0.

Emergency Management Training was attended by Tom Jacobs. He reported the update.

Discussion of safety plan for future events will be scheduled. Schams Avenue sign and post is missing and new one was delivered. Fire numbers in St. Joseph were discussed. Painting lines on parking lot was discussed. A few residents inquired about condemning or removing the shed behind the bank. It needs to be repaired immediately or condemned. County is chip sealing CTY RD M beginning July 18, Discussed TRIP funds and Shelby receiving grants. Bridge at back of Breidel Coulee Rd. was discussed.
