

Town of Greenfield, La Crosse County
Regular Board Meeting
Minutes August 10, 2016

Chairman Mader called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. with the Pledge of Allegiance at N1800 Town Hall Rd., La Crosse, WI 54601. Supervisors Tom Jacobs and Brandon Wright were present. Treasurer Mary Leuck was present. Clerk Lois Meinking was present. The clerk read the minutes of the July 13, 2016 meeting. Motion Jacobs/Mader to approve as amended. Motion passed 3-0. The clerk read the minutes of the closed session July 13, 2016. Motion Wright/Jacobs to approve minutes as read. Motion passed 3-0. The treasurer read the financial report for July. Motion Jacobs/Wright to approve report. Motion passed 3-0. Loan for \$90,000 reviewed at 3.85% for road repairs.

Election report was given by the clerk. 19% of registered voters voted August 9. The following will be on the ballot Nov. 8: U.S. Senator Ron Johnson 83, Russ Feingold 137; Representative in 3rd Congressional District Ron Kind 123; State Senator District 32 Jennifer Shilling 135, Dan Kapanke 82; Representative to 94th Assembly Steve Doyle 133, Julian Bradley 69; Register of Deeds Cheryl A. McBride 69; District Attorney Tim Gruenke 128; County Clerk Ginny Dankmeyer 130; County Treasurer Shawn Handland 122. Motion Mader/Wright to approve additional election inspectors: Kalla Kalloway, Joseph Shikonya, Kathy Shikonya, Anne Risen, and Jay Ruetten. Motion passed 3-0.

Road and recycle report was given by the chairman. Complaints about public health hazard on Servais Collern. Discussed the street light on Bahr Road and need to check on trimming branches before school buses start running.

Ann and Dan Thill presented aerial photos of water run off problems on Birchview Circle/OA. They sought approval for a solution to create a berm to redirect water.

Meadow Ridge pavement repair bids from Mathy and Klaetsch were discussed. There is a meeting scheduled on August 17 at the site at 6:30 P.M.

Butch Miller presented information and aerial maps regarding Right-of-Way at N1496 Wuensch Road. He proposed bringing the Right-of Way to 33' vacating back to the standard recorded document. Original deed was 1968. The current 75' total and 1984 drainfield was discussed. He would need to get this certified with the county. Motion Jacobs/Wright to abandon property outside normal right-of-way. Motion passed 3-0 unanimously. Discussed needing 100' School bus turnarounds.

Citizen Comments: Request from 4-H to donate a trophy/award case for the hall. Motion to approve the donation Mader/Jacobs. 4-H will check with fire department about AED location. Motion passed 3-0. Reviewed weeds on Breidel Coulee Road at Jacobsen property. Resident requested consideration of a walking path in St. Joseph. The park was discussed.

Motion Mader/Jacobs to adjourn meeting and pay bills at 7:48 P.M. Meeting adjourned.
