

Town of Greenfield, La Crosse County
Regular Board Meeting
Minutes September 14, 2016

Chairman Mader called the meeting to order at 7:02 P.M. with the Pledge of Allegiance at N1800 Town Hall Rd., La Crosse, WI 54601. Supervisors Tom Jacobs and Brandon Wright were present. Treasurer Mary Leuck was excused. Clerk Lois Meinking was present. The clerk read the minutes of the August 10, 2016 meeting. Motion Wright/Jacobs to approve as amended. Motion passed 3-0. The clerk read the minutes of the special meeting August 17, 2016. Motion Mader/Wright to approve minutes as read. Motion passed 3-0.

The recycle report was given by Chairman Mader and Tom Jacobs. It will be updated and mailed to residents for 2017. Complaint at center about residents not splitting trash as needed. Board will handle.

The road report was given tree trimming and road patching done on East Hills Road. Schieche Rd. is washing out on the north side of the bridge. Schmaltz Rd. has an issue with debris.

Meadow Ridge Road repair was discussed. The Board has not come to an agreement. Mr. Fechner was present. Hess Excavating could be contacted to look at drainage. There is concern that accepting the bids may not resolve problem. Mader/Wright motion to defer until April and have Hess look at it for a drainage solution. Motion passed 3-0.

Complaints received on weeds in lawns on private property. Some corrected and concern about abandoned home.

Butch Miller discussed the request to vacate excess easement on N1496 Wuensch Road. He discussed it with Dan Leis (county zoning). Town attorney will be contacted regarding State Stats 82.11 (82.10, 82.11) and procedures needed (hearing, recorded document). Original deed was 1968. The current 75' total and 1984 drain field was discussed.

Citizen comments: Blood Center of Wisconsin Drive Mon., October 3 1-6 PM at Town Hall; West Salem Superintendent will be at October meeting; Resolution to exceed the levy in October will need approval; Budget hearing Nov. 14; Concern in Servais Collern Terrace-restrictions/covenants. Boats, campers, and trailers stored in driveways and yards (Koenen's reported 12/21 homes are original owners); Striping the parking lot needs to be done; Erosion concern at W4065 Birchview Circle started in 2013-photos provided. Report of doors unlocked to fire trucks and shop September 11. Treasurer's report will be posted.

Motion Wright/Jacobs to adjourn meeting at 7:47 P.M. Meeting adjourned.
