Regular Board Meeting Minutes
November 9, 2016

Chairman Steve Mader opened the meeting at 7:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance at N1800 Town Hall Rd., La Crosse, WI 54601. Supervisor Tom Jacobs was present. Treasurer Mary Leuck was present. Clerk Lois Meinking was present. The clerk read the minutes of the October 12, 2016 regular meeting. Motion Jacobs/ Mader to approve minutes as amended. Motion passed 2-0. The treasurer gave the financial report for October. Motion to approve financial report Jacobs/Mader. Motion passed 2-0.

Ken Malzacher and Jim Bottcher (representative) were present to request changes to CUP #740 at N2096 Malzacher Rd. La Crosse, WI. Tires have recently been removed. Board members reviewed expectation of no vehicles without licenses. Plan Commission member Barry Nelson was present and consulted. There was discussion of the 50' X 90" building and a request for a fenced area. Motion Mader/Jacobs to revise CUP #740 to allow existing building size 50' X 90' to be included in original conditional use permit but not to include additional storage of cars or parts. Motion passed unanimously 2-0. No fence permitted.

Board discussed shed in disrepair owned by First National Bank. The Board discussed action needs to be taken within 20 days.

Public hearing will be held to vacate partial right of way on Wuensch Rd. November 23 at 6 p.m. followed by plan commission meeting and Special Town Board meeting.

Budget hearing and tax levy setting meeting will begin at 6:00 p.m. November 28, 2016 at the Town Hall. N1800 Town Hall Rd., La Crosse, WI 54601. Motion by Mader/Jacobs to set date and post budget. Motion passed 2-0 unanimously.

Supervisor 2 vacancy discussed. Interested residents should contact the clerk. April 4, 2017 election for all Town offices. Interested residents should file by 5 pm January 3, 2017.
