Regular Board Meeting
Minutes December 14, 2016

Chairman Mader called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. at N1800 Town Hall Road, La Crosse, WI with the Pledge of Allegiance. Supervisor Tom Jacobs was present. Treasurer Mary Leuck was present. Clerk Lois Meinking was present. The clerk read the minutes of November 9, 2016 meeting.

Mader/Jacobs to approve as amended. Minutes approved 2-0. Minutes of Budget Hearing and Levy Meeting November 28, 2016 read. Jacobs/Mader to approve. Motion passed 2-0. Treasurer presented financial report for November. Jacobs/Mader motion to approve report. Report approved 2-0.

FEMA report by chairman. Shieche Road and Kammel Coulee Road in process.

Storage shed at the bank. They will repair doors and siding in the next 90-100 days. Motion Mader/Jacobs to allow 120 days to fix it. Motion passed 2-0 unanimously.

Darrel attended safety snow plowing training in Town of Campbell. They offered a slot to towns with a certified trainer.

Supervisor 2 is still open. Papers are available to those interested in running for Town office April 4, 2017. Motion Mader/Jacobs to appoint Andy Neubauer for Supervisor 2. Motion passed unanimously with clerk voting 3-0.

Randy Nedrelo was present from the La Crosse County household hazardous waste program. There is an increase per resident in 2017. The increase is \$1.25 per person. Businesses can bring waste for a fee. Mader/Jacobs motion to raise Household Hazardous Waste Program to \$1.25 per population. Motion passed unanimously 2-0.

Spring Election April 4 and papers were discussed. Residents interested in running for Town office 2-year term may start getting signatures in December. The 3 forms are filed by 5:00 p.m. January 5, 2017 in clerk's office.

Citizen comments: 23 acres purchased by county highway department from Garry Bahr. Information on rezoning the property and further review. St Joseph Construction donations. Painting interior of building. Question about dumpsters being too full. Will be increasing the size of the dumpsters. Mobile Home tax question. Questions on Wuensch Rd. Town stones with Hall and date stone are going to deteriorate (suggested solutions). Pick-up truck considered at annual meeting. Discussed the need for a mower.
