

Town of Greenfield, La Crosse County Wisconsin
Regular Board Meeting
Minutes January 11, 2017

Chairman Mader opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance at the Town Hall N1800 Town Hall Road La Crosse, WI 54601. Supervisors Tom Jacobs and Andy Neubauer were present. Treasurer Mary Leuck was present. Clerk Lois Meinking was present. The clerk read the minutes of the December 14, 2016 meeting. Motion made Jacobs/Mader to approve as amended. Motion passed 3-0. The treasurer gave the financial report for December 2016. Motion made Jacobs/Neubauer to approve report. Motion passed 3-0. Recycling money was from last year not this month. The treasurer has collected \$1.5 million in taxes thus far.

The interior of the hall has been painted recently. Discussed building used for snowmobile class and certification. Town computer may not be used.

December 24 Recycle Center was closed as provided in Recycler and on-line. Although residents showed up. The Recycle Center will be closed Tuesday, July 4 and open Wed. July 5 instead. Extra 2017 recyclers are available at the center. Ken Hoeth Recycling Engineer was present at the meeting. The discussion of an RFP for 3-year services/contract was discussed. Discussion of County Household Hazardous Waste brochures and meeting with staff was discussed.

Truck Report was given. Lost Ridge was hand sand/salted. Vehicles sitting during process. Hess assisted. Discussed completing 911 signs. Wuensch Rd. split. Chairman will speak with Steve Miller (only home). That section of Wuensch Road was named Muenzenberger Rd. years ago.

Discussed purchasing a used mower from Titan. It was sold. Town is still looking for used mower.

Charlie Handy was present for zoning issues. Ron Chamberlain was present from county highway department. County is in a Real Estate transaction for 23 acres owned by Garry Bahr on STATE RD 33. Needs perk results/public facilities zoning/tree planting/living snow fence and mowing grass. They are planning for a 9 truck bay. County is resizing sand facilities and closing site at Hillview reverting back to county. Site in St. Joseph would be put up for sale. Charlie Handy provided timeline and sample resolution/ordinance. Takes about a month to go over comprehensive plan, commission makes recommendation to Board, plan a hearing 60 days minimum. From the start Comprehensive Plan amendment takes 75 days. Highway Department can make application during the process.

Charlie Handy discussed Shoreland Zoning. All Towns in county have Shoreland Zoning. Potential Public Hearing at county in February. County is seeking Town input. Board reviewing information. February 8th meeting set to discuss revising Plan. Commission meets at 6:30 pm.

Citizen comments: Stark Rd. icy; be patient Town of Greenfield roads have been maintained well by plow crew. Are they ever going to fix CTY RD M to BARRE? Snow dams above fire department doors will be addressed in summer. Compressor problems for Fire Department; Wehrs Electric is fixing issue of no air for truck. Greg Roesler on Temp Road has concern about spring off driveway (pipe to creek?) pond is in Right of Way. Tax collection dates: Jan 21, 28, 30 (9:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m.); Jan. 26, 30 (noon – 6:00 p.m.)

Motion to adjourn to pay bills Jacobs/Neubauer. Meeting adjourned 7:57 p.m.
