Minutes April 12, 2017
Regular meeting

Chairman Mader opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:00 pm at N1800 Town Hall Rd., La Crosse, WI 54601. Supervisors Tom Jacobs and Andy Neubauer were present. Treasurer Mary Leuck was present. Clerk Lois Meinking was present. The clerk read the minutes of the March 8, 2017 regular meeting. Motion by Jacobs/Neubauer to approve minutes. Minutes approved 3-0. The treasurer presented the March financial report. Motion by Jacobs/Neubauer to approve treasurer's report. Motion passed 3-0.

The clerk gave the election results for the spring election which was over 19% turn out. State Superintendent of Public Instruction Tony Evers 200, Lowell E Holtz 53; Justice of Supreme Court Annette Ziegler 193; Court of Appeals Judge District 4 Michael R. Fitzpatrick 190; Town Chairperson Steve Mader 219; Town Board Supervisor 1 Thomas Jacobs 219; Town Board Supervisor 2 Andrew Neubauer 213; Town Clerk Lois Meinking 226; Town Treasurer Mary Leuck 242; La Crosse School Board Member Allen Pruitt 42, Connie L Troyanek 74, Dave Rudolph 69, Laurie Cooper Stoll 69; West Salem School Board Member Syl Clements 93, Catherine Griffin 94; Westby Area School District Cary Joholski 7, Gerald Roethel 8; County advisory referenda Yes 142, No 119.

Road inspection notes were reviewed and priority projects were set for repair, sealcoating, and new pavement. Adding a portion of Birch Lane was discussed. Motion to accept road report and bids by May 10, 2017 Jacobs/Mader. Motion passed 3-0.

The public hearing on amending the comprehensive plan and change in land use was reviewed from April 11th. There is a 30 day waiting period to receive and respond to public comments. The next special meeting was set for May 18 at 6:30 p.m.

The Lions Club requested a picnic liquor license for beer and wine for the Spring Fling April 21. Motion Jacobs/Neubauer to approve the license. Motion passed 3-0.

The recycle center and road reports were given by Chairman Mader. There is a request for a concrete pad under a container at the center. It was reviewed with a discussion of 30'-40' maximum. The Town purchased the land 30-40 years ago.

There was discussion for the need for a new mower. The Bomford has been cutting brush and grass for 30 years. Terry Schams was present from Titan to provide bids. There was a review of a rear mount and mid mount. There was discussion of trading in the old or considering selling it to Temp. The town cuts 3 inch diameter saplings and spent \$9000 on repairs last year. A cab is needed due to parsnips. Is it possible to rent a tractor or work with a neighboring town to purchase (@ 200 hours a year)?

Citizen Comments: The public facilities county purchase was discussed on State Road 33. There was discussion to insist on a berm and getting a turn lane.
