Road Report discussed. Tree trimming on Hickory and Valleywood Springs is complete. Residents wanted the logs. 30 sign posts need to be installed.

Recycle Center Report. Reviewed Uline products for community events at hall and park. Appliance Container needed clarification from Hilltopper RFP. The Board did not intend a separate white container for appliances. They will be left on the ground as in past and called for pick up by Tom when there are about 15.

Strangstalien property on Cemetery Lane was discussed. The Mobile home must be removed when property is sold.

Ten Mile Circle Sign needs to be replaced with post. Sign was ordered. Fire numbers update. They were ordered and need to be installed on the private road (Clements).

New plow truck bids considered in June: Peterbilt, Kenworth, International, Universal.

Citizen Comments: Request about lighting on Bahr Rd. & HWY 33 Xcel Energy. State can put up a sign. Discussed N1640 Meadow Ridge Road solutions.
