Minutes November 8, 2017  
Regular Town Board Meeting

Town Planning Commission meeting was called to order by Steve Mader at 6:45 P.M. Members present: Dave Hansen, Alex Clason, Barry Nelson, Tom Jacobs, Andy Neubauer, Steve Mader and Lois Meinking. Stan Clements presented a rezoning request for his homestead property on Clements Rd. to go from Exc. Ag to Rural. Application Number 2006 for County Zoning will meet to review his request.

Chairman Mader called the regular meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:00 P.M. at N1800 Town Hall Rd., La Crosse, WI 54601. Supervisors Tom Jacobs and Andy Neubauer were present. Treasurer Mary Leuck was present. Clerk Lois Meinking was present. The clerk read the minutes of the October 11, 2017 meeting. Motion Jacobs/Neubauer to approve minutes. Motion passed unanimously 3-0. The treasurer presented the financial report for October 2017. Motion Jacobs/Neubauer to approve financial report. Motion passed unanimously 3-0.

Bids were opened and reviewed for plow truck and box from Allstate Peterbilt, Debauche, Freightliner, La Crosse Truck Center, Universal, and Wisconsin Kenworth. They will be discussed at a special meeting November 14 beginning at 6:15 P.M. prior to the Budget hearing.

Stan Clements presented rezoning request on homestead property from Exc. Ag to Rural. Motion Mader/Jacobs to approve rezoning from Exc Ag to Rural. This is county zoning application number 2006.

Al Bliss and Dave Sawvell County Health Department were present to share information about well testing. Tips were provided and questions answered. Information was distributed and test kits were available. Kits are at the hall.

Implements of Husbandry ordinance was reviewed. Motion Jacobs/Neubauer to approve keeping current ordinance as is. Motion passed unanimously 3-0.

Motion Jacobs/Neubauer to enter into intergovernmental agreement for Household Hazardous Waste with La Crosse County this year for ten years. Motion passed unanimously 3-0.

Citizen Comments: Clements Rd. old business discussed with attorney feedback. 66' width of road unless 49.5' works which needs to be surveyed. Advised getting estimates. Road length is .4 of a mile. Special assessments to property owners. If consider converting then get advice from highway commissioner and hold meeting of residents. Greg Roesler was present to inform Town some corn is off now and would like review. Fire department needs phone and we have one. Shelby and City of La Crosse agreement was questioned. Crew should be prepared with a couple pallets of salt (Larry?). Discussed home in Brookview that needs to be demolished. Motion Jacobs/Neubauer to adjourn at 8:21 P.M. to pay bills. Meeting adjourned.
