

Town of Greenfield, La Crosse County, Wisconsin
Regular Meeting Minutes
February 14, 2018

Chairman Mader called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:00 p.m. at the Town Hall N1800 Town Hall Rd., La Crosse, WI 54601. Supervisors Tom Jacobs and Andy Neubauer were present. Treasurer Mary Leuck was present. Clerk Lois Meinking was present. The clerk read the minutes of the January regular meeting. Motion Jacobs/Mader to approve minutes as amended. Motion passed 3-0. The treasurer presented the financial report for January. Motion Jacobs/Neubauer to approve report. Motion passed 3-0. Discussion on road loan payment dates and truck reserve fund. Plan to wait until tax settlement. Truck and sand/salt spreader \$163,655.

FEMA DR4343 process was updated and Schieche Road Repair bids for DR4288 were received. Motion Mader/Jacobs to award bid to Hess Excavating. Motion passed 3-0.

Lot 25 Ridgeview legal opinion discussed. The town never approved the pond.

Additional poll workers were discussed. Motion Jacobs/Neubauer to approve additional poll workers. Motion passed 3-0.

Reducing number of election inspectors when feasible as permitted by law was discussed. Motion Mader/Neubauer to approve Resolution 2018-1 to allow clerk to reduce number of poll workers. Motion passed 3-0.

Discussed letter to land owners on farming in the right of way restrictions and limiting access to field roads to existing point and need for landowners to improve and widen access to limit damage to town roads. Farming in right of way Stat. 86.021 is not allowed and we need to mandate grass areas to reduce flooding. Statute allows for a fine and triple damage to roads per Rick Manthe WTA legal counsel. Motion Mader/Jacobs to table until next meeting.

Revision to county livestock rules in platted subdivisions (chickens, rabbits) was discussed. No consensus.

Request for Shelby Fire chief Waller to drop \$140 bill to Bangor Fire Department for fire on Antony Road. Motion Mader/Jacobs to deny giving up bill. Motion passed 3-0.

CCFC 2% fire dues of \$289.58 was discussed.

Issue of clearing snow on sidewalk Highway 33. Property owners are responsible to clear within 24 hours of snow storm.

Updated Parking ordinance was discussed. Concern with cars parked on roads.

Citizen Comments: Cracks on Highland Drive need to be tarred and filled. Al Radke and Matt Sweeney were present to discuss Clements Road. Matthew Sweeney is interested in purchasing 23 acres. WTA attorney said the road needs to have 12" gravel, 3" blacktop with 100 ft. turn-around. There is a concern with emergency vehicles and soft gravel. There needs to be a compacted road base and 3" hot mix blacktop. A survey needs to be completed. 2 owners need an easement.
