Regular Meeting
Minutes August 8, 2018

Chairman Mader called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. at the Town Hall N1800 Town Hall Rd., La Crosse, WI. Supervisors Tom Jacobs and Andy Neubauer were present. Treasurer Mary Leuck was present. Clerk Lois Meinking was present. The clerk read the minutes of July 11 meeting. Motion Jacobs/Neubauer to approve minutes as amended. Motion passed 3-0. Clerk read the minutes of July 27th joint meeting with Town of Washington. Motion Jacobs/Neubauer to approve minutes as presented. Motion passed 3-0. The treasurer presented the financial report for June 2018. Motion Jacobs/Neubauer to approve financial report. Motion passed 3-0.

Request from Stacy Burns for beer/wine picnic license for St. Joseph Parish Picnic Sept 9 at the park beginning at 10:30 a.m. Motion Jacobs/Mader to approve picnic license. Motion passed 3-0.

Revaluation proposal from Associated Appraisal Consultants, Inc. was reviewed and discussed. Discuss in October as the budget will be discussed.

New truck arrived and is paid for. Signage is needed. Motion Mader/Jacobs to advertise old truck for sale in the newspaper with a minimum sealed bid of \$5000. Motion passed 3-0.

Road report discussed meeting with Town of Washington on Kammel Coulee Road spillway and closing road. We would pay no more than 20% to fix. We need to widen Town turnaround and put up barrier. Town of Washington needs 6 residents to sign a petition to close road they do not want to repair.

Recycle Center report to put concrete beneath dumpsters. Motion Mader/Jacobs to get bids for concrete beneath dumpsters. Motion passed 3-0.

Landscape and bark for hall cost \$440.

FEMA update. Not much to report except a telephone survey.

Fire dues to CCFC \$280.15 of the \$7,003.79 (4%).

Notice of WTA meeting in Town of Barre (Hall) August 23 6:30 picnic/7:30 P.M. unit meeting. Plan Commission invited.

Schmaltz Road issue discussed and meeting with Bruce Olson Land Conservationist on how to fix it. Filling in option to create a water diversion. Permission needed from DNR to go to creek. An emergency to fund this year. Inlet boxes are needed. Needs to go out for bids. Tom Sanger would donate fill and trees. Motion Mader/Neubauer to adjust spending to fix Schmaltz ditch. Motion passed 3-0.

Wisconsin DOT will be paving US HWY 14/61 from Brickyard Lane Fireclay Ct to CTHM in 2023 but could be moved up. Chairman contacted DOT. Motion Mader/Jacobs to request by letter the DOT take care of trees and brush at northeast intersection of CTY RD Yy and US 14/61 to improve visibility; consider increasing the length of eastbound passing lane on US 14/61 at Skemp Rd.; change County Road Yy so intersection is at 90 degree angle at US HWY 14/61. Motion passed 3-0.

Citizen Comments: Burning permit needed by Ken Steiger; Farm ditch culvert discussed at Steiger farm; Fire number for Nicole Rogala discussed; tree on Highland Drive and Bahr Road is on private property; Nathan Warnberg discussed Kaukauna Town Hall and energy savings (geo thermal panels), Tim Gulden is a contact; Ten Mile Cir. sign and post bent May 12th event; Scott Construction will be back in area in a couple weeks.

Motion Mader/Jacobs to adjourn meeting to pay bills at 8:03 P.M. Meeting adjourned.
