Regular Meeting Minutes
January 10, 2018

Chairman Mader called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:00 p.m. at the Town Hall N1800 Town Hall Rd., La Crosse, WI 54601. Supervisor Tom Jacobs was present. Supervisor Andy Neubauer was excused. Clerk Lois Meinking was present. Treasurer Mary Leuck was present. The clerk read the minutes of the December regular meeting. Motion Jacobs/Mader to approve the minutes. Motion passed 2-0. The clerk read the minutes of the Special Meeting December 27, 2017. Motion Jacobs/Mader to approve minutes. Motion passed 2-0. The treasurer gave the financial report for December 2017. Motion Mader/Jacobs to approve report. Motion passed 2-0.

Discussion on new truck reserve fund and loan repayment date. The temporary loan of \$90,000 is due March 1st. Putting money in the truck fund will be discussed after the February tax settlement.

Road report was given. Hickory Lane off FO has ice from spring water and Temp Rd. need extra salt. Land conservationist met with Steve, Tom and Greg Roesler.

Calls with complaints on Clements road were discussed and property for sale.

Retention pond in Ridgeview Heights was addressed by the Town attorney. In January 10 telephone conversation with Jim McNeilly indicated that the current developer, KST, will take care of the necessary repair of the storm water retention pond located partially on Lot 25 in the Ridgeview Heights subdivision. This is with the understanding that KST will work with the town in order to arrive at a written Maintenance Agreement with respect to the future maintenance. Legal advice report was reviewed.

There were no citizen comments.
